Wishing you a focused and energetic return to the office.



IFRA information letter 1189: New CMRs entering the labelling manual

IFRA provided this information for consultation by its members and associated trade associations.

The consultation runs until September 30, 2024.

The CLH proposals for Repr. 1B of bourgeonal and cyclamal groups (c2fbb2e4-37bc-4f21-aaa3-7db893aebf1b (europa.eu) will be discussed on 20 September 2024 by the ECHA RAC.

IFRA will be participating with two experts to defend the non-classification as Rep. 1B.

On 22 August 2024, France submitted the CLH dossier for Galaxolide (CAS: 1222-05-5) for an accordance check to ECHA.

France proposes a Repr. 1B, H360Df classification. As usual, IFRA's CMR&ED WG will manage the defence.

Meeting with the Cosmetic, Toiletry and Fragrance Association of Singapore (CTFAS)

Dr Caroline Li, Regional Director Asia Pacific, attended a meeting with The Cosmetic, Toiletry and Fragrance Association of Singapore (CTFAS) in July 2024.

CTFAS is highly influential ASEAN countries. The association has been pivotal in the establishment and implementation of cosmetic directives in this region.

IFRA has joined CTFAS and cooperation between the two associations is expected to have positive impacts for the fragrance as well as cosmetic industries in the ASEAN countries.

Webinars for IFRA members on Asia Pacific regulation update

IFRA in APAC provides regular webinars for our members regarding regulation updates in the region.

In July, IFRA hosted the Korea Regulatory Monitoring webinar, presented by the REACH24H Korea team. Over 30 people participated in the webinar. The purpose was to provide updates on the Korean regulatory landscape and its relevance to the fragrance industry (substances/end-product regulation).

The scope included K-REACH, K-BPR, Cosmetic& Quasi-Drugs, Drugs precursors, microplastics requirements, and other requirements raised by the members. The next webinar well beheld in September.

Newly elected MEPs prepare for 'La Rentrée' in the European Parliament IFRA presents recommendations for a resilient and competitive Europe

In June, 720 new MEPs were elected for a 5-year term and have now joined various Committees to shape legislation. The ENVI Committee, significant for IFRA, includes 90 members and is politically influential.

IFRA is actively engaging with MEPs to introduce the industry and share <u>Policy Recommendations</u> aimed at fostering resilience and competitiveness in Europe. This effort is in collaboration with IFRA Europe National Associations.

In September and October, IFRA will continue discussions with the various European Commission services, building on June's meetings and reflecting on past learnings and setting priorities for the next 5 years.

The fragrance value chain SSbD case study finalised IFRA conducted an SSbD assessment on a fragrance ingredient.

In September 2024, IFRA will publish its SSbD case study assessing the suitability and feasibility of the SSbD Framework, proposed by the Commission, on a fragrance ingredient: methyl salicylate.

The followed methodology and the results obtained will be soon presented to the IFRA members and to the CPG companies.

The report will be used as an advocacy tool to follow-up with the Commission on the gaps and limitations of the SSbD Framework and discuss the IFRA recommendations to make this Framework workable for the fragrance industry.

Insight from two-day awareness programme

Journey to Sustainable Jasmine Cultivation and Processing: Farmers, Scientists, and Processors Awareness Meet and Capacity Building, 1-2 July 2024

The primary objective of this program is to understand the issues and challenges faced by farmers and the local industry and to suggest methods for promoting responsible and sustainable farming practices in jasmine cultivation and processing.

The program witnessed participation of over 150 attendees, including more than 125 farmers engaged in jasmine cultivation and industry leaders.

During the interaction session, many farmers and processors shared their views by mentioning the problems faced related to cultivation & marketing.

The awareness meeting was followed by a visit to the jasmine fields in the Mettupalayam region of Tamil Nadu.

Peru

Public consultation: draft regulation for the Integrated Management of Chemical Substances

The comment deadline for the draft regulation is 23 October 2024.

On 23 July the Peruvian Ministry of the Environment (MINAN) published the draft regulation for Legislative Decree No. 1570/2023, on the Integrated Management of Chemical Substances in that country (Ministerial Resolution N° 00214-2024-MINAM).

The draft regulation was subsequently opened for public consultation for a period of ten business days. On 13 August, however, MINAM issued Resolution No. 00231-2024, extending the comment period on the draft regulation for Legislative Decree 1570 until 24 October.

Peru also notified the draft Regulation of Legislative Decree No. 1570 to the World Trade Organization (WTO). The notification was made on August 28, 2024, and will be open for comments for 60 days following the notification.

FCA-EPA New Chemicals Fragrance Work Groups Are Leading the Way

FCA's joint work groups with EPA are making progress to remove roadblocks to new fragrance chemical reviews.

FCA and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are meeting on a regular basis and working to address the remaining technical and regulatory issues affecting new fragrance chemical reviews.

FCA has secured an EPA commitment to refine conservative default assumptions and is working to provide the EPA with the data needed to update these numbers

FCA Successfully Advocated for Sound Science Outcomes in New York and California

FCA defeated or mitigated potentially problematic legislation in three states, while monitoring and engaging on a variety of bills in over 20 other states as needed.

Most US states have adjourned for the 2024 legislative session, during which FCA successfully defeated hazard-based bills in California and New York that would have banned ingredients in various product categories and lessened the potential negative impact of legislation in Vermont.

Legislation continues to move in California, where FCA is advocating for policies that allow for continued industry innovation.
